



Food for Learning Special Project Request

Food for Learning primarily provides funding for student nutrition programs (breakfast, lunch, snack), however, we recognize that there are many other food related activities that occur during the school year, each benefiting students by providing nutrition. Food for Learning will now accept applications for funding to support projects/events hosted by local schools. The focus of this funding is to explore innovative projects/events/activities that promote the mission of Food for Learning and will provide nutrition to students in an effort to enhance learning. Principals are encouraged to share this information with their School Councils.

Please note the following:

- These funds are to be used only towards the cost providing healthy food to students.
- Food provided must meet MCYS nutrition guidelines (same criteria as student nutrition programs)
- Food is provided only to students
- Food is not being sold
- Receipts for all purchases must be returned to Food for Learning upon completion of the project/event, attached to the 'Food for Learning Special Project Expense Form'
- Preference will be given to applications that will benefit students who would otherwise not be able to participate/benefit in the project/event
- \$500 maximum per application
- Schools can apply once per academic year

Events that do not qualify for this funding includes, but is not limited to*:

- School fundraisers
- Regularly scheduled sporting events
- EQAO testing
- Events normally considered to be part of the Board and/or school budgets
- Class assignments
- Class/school field trips

(* unless certain families cannot afford to participate and the student would be excluded without funding)

Schools may apply for these funds at any time during the year.

Applications will be reviewed by the Food for Learning Finance Committee. Responses will be provided by email within five days of receipt of application.
